Since 2000 she's been a proud member of the Rome's National Registered Architect Association.

Her collaboration with Walter Franchini (68.5 mt M/Y LADY ANNE for Amels shipyard), Luca Dini and Francesco Paszkowski paved her way to the yacht interior design through the most innovative photorealistic techniques, accurate choice of furniture and fittings for yacht interiors, successful cooperation with yacht suppliers and effective yacht management.

Important partnerships with Italian and foreign Shipyards resulted also in collaboration with Columbus Yacht by Cantieri Palumbo, working on Taiba — a 57m Italian yacht.
